TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD, COUNTY OF OAKLAND:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that any qualified elector of Bloomfield Township, who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Bloomfield Township Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State Branch office; or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at <https://mi.gov/vote> and mailed to the Bloomfield Township Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 21, 2019**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Bloomfield Township Clerk's Office, 4200 Telegraph, Bloomfield Hills, MI 48302 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday – Thursday, 7:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.
- Friday, November 1, 2019, 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Saturday, November 2, 2019, 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2019, 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Charter Township of Bloomfield will vote on the following millage proposal:
Oakland Community College Operating Millage Renewal Proposal**

This proposal authorizes Oakland Community College to continue to levy 0.7545 mills for operating purposes for 10 years as a renewal of millage previously approved by the electors in 2010, which expires with the 2021 tax levy.

**Voters in the Birmingham Public School District will also vote on the following millage proposal:
Birmingham Public Schools Replacement Operating Millage Proposal**

This proposal would restore, replace and extend the authority of the Birmingham Public Schools to levy up to 18.00 mills for general school district operating purposes on taxable property in the School District to the extent that such property is not exempt from such levy and would restrict the levy on principal residences (owner occupied homes) to no more than 14.24 mills.
